### **ENEOS Xplora Malaysia receives Petroleum Arrangement Contractor (PAC) of the Year – Sapphire Award**

ENEOS Xplora Inc. (“ENEOS Xplora”) is pleased to announce that its subsidiary, ENEOS Xplora Malaysia Limited (“Xplora Malaysia”), has received the PAC of the Year – Sapphire Award at The Emerald Awards 2026, hosted by Malaysia Petroleum Management (“MPM”), , Petroliaam Nasional Berhad (PETRONAS). This also marks the first time a Japanese company has received this award.

In Malaysia, many companies are engaged in oil and gas operation under the leadership of PETRONAS. The Emerald Awards recognize contributions made in 2025 to oil and gas operations in Malaysia across a wide range of fields, including safety, environmental stewardship, stable operations, and human resource development. Xplora Malaysia’s receipt of this award reflects the high level of technical capability demonstrated through safe and stable operations at the SK10 Block off the coast of Sarawak, Malaysia, as well as its long-standing partnership with PETRONAS.

After acquiring the SK10 Block in 1987, we commenced production at the Helang gas field in 2003. Since then, we have steadily expanded our operations in close collaboration with PETRONAS through continued development within the block, including the start of production at the Layang oil and gas field in 2017 and the Beryl gas field in 2018. In recognition of its long-term contributions, we agreed with PETRONAS last year to extend the Production Sharing Contract for the SK10 Block by an additional ten years. Additionally in 2024, through its subsidiary, we acquired a 50% participating interest in five undeveloped gas fields containing high concentrations of CO<sub>2</sub>, located offshore Peninsular Malaysia (“BIGST”). Together with PETRONAS subsidiary acting as the operator, we are currently undertaking activities to advance BIGST toward its development phase.

Furthermore, ENEOS Xplora participates in LNG liquefaction\*<sup>2</sup> through a 10% equity interest in PETRONAS LNG 9 Sdn. Bhd., a subsidiary of PETRONAS. We also agreed with PETRONAS to acquire a 10% equity stake in Malaysia LNG Tiga Sdn. Bhd. (“MLNG Tiga”), another PETRONAS subsidiary engaged in LNG liquefaction operations\*<sup>3</sup>.

Gas produced from the SK10 Block is liquefied at facilities including MLNG Tiga and exported as LNG to Asian countries, including Japan. As part of its corporate strategy, ENEOS Xplora is strengthening its operator excellence, asset evaluation capabilities, and strong relationships with producing countries. Leveraging the technology and experience it has accumulated, we will continue to contribute to the stable supply of energy to Asia, including Japan as the operator of the SK10 Block.



\*1 Operator: The entity responsible for planning and conducting petroleum exploration, development, and production activities within a block.

\*2 On April 1, 2026, the natural gas business within the ENEOS Group was integrated into the Company (announced on November 12, 2025).

\*3 The Company previously participated in the project since 1995; however, its participation expired in 2023, and it agreed to re-enter the project this year (announced on April 30, 2026).
